Material List

Drawing Basics I:

- **PAPER**  
18" x 24" white drawing paper  
Optional for charcoal or pastels---colored drawing paper (Canson Teintes);  
also gray bogus 12"x 18"
- **PENCILS**  
2B, 4B, 6B, HB, H, Ebony
- **ERASERS**  
A kneaded eraser; a gum or plastic eraser
- **CHARCOAL**  
2B, 4B, 6B and a sandpaper block or a piece of sandpaper  
Optional for use on gray or colored paper---white charcoal pencil
- **TORTILLIONS**  
2-3 small; 2-3 large (separate sets for use with charcoal and pastels)

Drawing Basics II: Experienced students should come to the first class with the above list **ONLY**.  
The following materials listed below may be used in future classes as needed.

- **DRAWING INK**  
One bottle of Higgins or Speedball drawing ink (waterproof)
- **PEN POINTS**  
One penholder (plastic, no cork top)  
One C-6 or another fine Speedball pen point  
One crowquill pen holder, 2 crowquill pen points
- **PASTELS (SOFT OR OIL PASTELS)**  
One good quality set of basic colors (should have a true red, gold, a flesh tone and black and white)  
Optional: 8"x10" sheets of very fine gauge sandpaper
